

# 2010 Coalition Action Plan Summary

- Create community partnerships that target program specific needs.
- Work to encompass program resources for the Hispanic population.
- Expand community programs and develop a structured programmatic approach for the developmental stages of a child's cycle of life as the transitions relate to safety.
- Utilize Public Health epidemiologist to gather local data of injury and deaths that occur in Muscogee County.
- Measure effectiveness of Safe Kids programs through qualitative evaluations.
- Maintain high visibility in the community through constant use of media outlets.
- Work to make Safe Kids Columbus the optimal safety resource for family support and education.
- Revise BUCKS system to allow for on-site incentives for volunteers.
- Explore a miniature safety village that will combine all safety education into one facility and promote increased collaboration for possible development in Columbus (Form a working committee made of interested community members and safe kids board members).
